AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: A 0.094-acre area of submerged lands in the Fresno River at Madera, Madera County.

Construction, operation and maintenance LAND USE: of telephone and telegraph facilities.

Continuous use plus one year from March 1, 1982.

CONSIDERATION: Exempt by law, Public Utilities Code Section 7901.

LAND DESCRIPTION

W 22874

A parcel of submerged land 10 feet wide in the Fresno River in the City of Madera, Madera County, California, lying 5 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

COMMENCING at the point of intersection of the centerlines of Central Avenue and the Southern Pacific Railroad right of way in the City of Madera, said point of intersection being also Railroad Station 4760+00; thence northwesterly along the centerline of said Railroad right of way 264 feet more or less; thence leaving said centerline northeasterly at right angles 55 feet more or less to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence northwesterly, parallel with and 5 feet northeasterly of said Railroad right of way 507 feet more or less to the end of the herein described centerline.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary low water mark of the Fresno River.
