For this reason, staff believes that the non-refundable expense deposit should be waived.

- 2. This water metering facility will be used in the allocation of water volumes to various parties. The improvements consist of a concrete sill, concrete headwalls, and earthfill on each side to direct flows.
- 3. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100.
- 4. A negative declaration was prepared and certified by the City of Bakersfield, pursuant to CEQA and the State EIR Guidelines. The City of Bakersfield found that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 5. The project is situated on lands not identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1.


