RECEIPT OF A "NOTICE OF PROPOSED USE
OF STATE LANDS"

PROVIDED FOR BY THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES AND
THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION

BACKGROUND:

On February 8, 1974, the Commission authorized the issuance of a ten-year Public Agency Permit from April 1, 1972 to the Department of Water Resources for the operation and maintenance of two fish release stations in the Sacramento and San Joaquin Rivers, adjacent to Sherman Island, Sacramento County.

On September 26, 1979, the State Lands Commission approved a Memorandum of Understanding, effective October 19, 1979, between the Department of Water Resources and the State Lands Commission. It provides for use of State lands for either the CVP or the State Water Resources Development System. Under the Memorandum of Understanding, the Department of Water Resources provides State Lands Commission with a "Notice of Proposed Use of State Lands".

PRESENT SITUATION:

The Department of Water Resources has advised staff that they desire to continue the operation of the two fish stations previously mentioned. They have filed with staff the required "Notice of Proposed Use of State Lands."

In accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding, staff will execute the "Notice of Proposed Use of State Lands".
