#### DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT:

Kaiser Steel Corporation, Napa Fabricating Plant

P. O. Box 390

Napa, California 94558

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands in the bed of the Napa River at Mile 13, Napa County.

LAND USE:

Dredge 25,000 cubic yards of accumulated sediments from area between navigation channel and applicant's docks to maintain barge access to docks.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period: Two years from May 1,

1982.

CONSIDERATION:

Royalty of \$0.15 per cubic yard for spoils placed in publicly-owned disposal sites; \$0.25 per cubic yard in the event dredged majerials are placed on private property, sold, or used for any private or commercial bijnefit.

the planned disposal area is Napa County

Disposal Site No. 4.

Applicant is owner of upland.

2. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values.

3. Staff has prepared a permit document which includes all the above provisions, a copy of which is on file in the offices of the Commission.

- 2. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE N° SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1 OF THE P.R.C.
- THE DREDGING PERMIT ON FILE IN THE OFFICES OF THE COMMISSION; SAID PERMISSION SHALL BE ISSUED IN CONSIDERATION

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OF ROYALTY FOR DREDGED MATERIALS OF \$0.15 PER CUBIC YARD, PLACED IN AN APPROVED THALIC DISPOSAL SITE: AND \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD PLACED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY, SOLD, OR USED FOR PRIVATE OR COMMERCIAL BENEFIT; SAID PERMIT SHALL BE FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS, BEGINNING JULY 1, 1931, AND SHALL ALLOW THE DREDGING OF A MAXIMUM OF 25,000 CUBIC YARDS OF SAND, SILT AND GRAVEL, EXCLUDING ALL OTHER MINERALS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, OIL, GAS AND GEOTHERMAL FROM AN AREA OF TIDE AND SUBNERGED LANDS IN THE NAPA RIVER, NAPA COUNTY; SAID AREA SEDESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO AND BY THIS REFERENCE EXPRESSLY MADE A PART HEREOF; MATERIALS DREDGED SHALL BE DEPOSITED ON AN UPLAND PUBLICLY-OWNER SITE, APPROVED BY ALL APPLICABLE REGULATORY AGENCIES.

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
