LAND DESCRIPTION

WP 5719

Twenty-three (23) parcels of tide and submerged land in the Old River, Contra Costa County, California, said parcels being adjacent to that parcel of land known as "Golden Isle" described in that Grant Deed recorded December 14, 1965, in Book 5013, at page 227, Official Records of Contra Costa County, more particularly described as follows:

PARCELS 1 - 18 FLOATING DOCKS

Eighteen (18) parcels of land lying immediately beneath 18 existing docks. TOGETHER WITH a necessary use area not to extend more than 10 feet from the extremities of said docks, said docks being adjacent to the above mentioned "Golden Isle".

PARCELS 19 - 23 PILINGS

Five (5) circular parcels of land 20 feet in diameter; the location of the center points being the center of 5 existing pilings, said pilings being westerly of the above mentioned "Golden Isle".

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion of the above described 23 parcels lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the Old River.
