- 1. The application proposes placement of a submarine communications cable in tide and submerged lands across Little River in Little River State Park on the west side of State Highway 1 near Crannell, Humboldt County.
- The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$225.
- 3. This project is exempt from CEQA because it is within the purview of 14 Cal. Adm. Code, Section 15103, which exempts construction of new small facilities or structures, and Section 15104, which exempts minor alteration of land and water.
- 4. This project is situated on land identified as possessing environmental values in that the State Lands Commission stated all waterways under the Commission's jurisdiction have environmental significance. Staff finds this project to be compatible with Commission policy.



AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY OF A GENERAL PERMIT RIGHT-OF-WAY USE, FROM AUGUST 1, 1982, FOR A PERIOD OF CONTINUOUS USE, PLUS ONE YEAR, WHICH IS EXEMPT FROM CONSIDERATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 7901, PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE; FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A SUBMAPINE CABLE CROSSING ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACL D AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
