ASSIGNMENT OF A PORTION OF LEASE NO. PRC 6072.2

The State Lands Commission authorized issuance to Charles A. Mitchell, Jr., of a ten-year Grazing Lease, running from January 1, 1981, at its meeting of October 30, 1981 (Minute Item 13). The lease involved a total of 41 parcels containing 23,083.20 acres, more or less, of State school land located in San Bernardino County and Iny; County, for a total rental of \$1,144.60 per annum, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on the fifth anniversary of the lease.

The leased school land is located in and adjoining two Bureau of Land Management (BLM) grazing allotment boundaries: the Valley Wells, and the Horsethief Springs Allotments. Mr. Mitchell also holds the grazing rights on 374,676 acres, more or less, of federal lands within these two allotments.

On May 10, 1982, Mr. Parker contacted the staff of the Commission and informed that he and his wife were acquiring the grazing rights to the federal lands in BLM's Valley Wells Allotment from Mr. Mitchell, and agreed to secure an assignment of the portion of Mr. Mitchell's State Lease No. PRC 6072.2, involving the State school lands situated in and adjoining that BLM grazing allotment. Appropriately executed and notarized assignment form were received in the office of the Commission on July 2, 1982.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The Assignor will continue, under the subject lease, to use for livestock grazing the remaining 16 parcels containing 8,626.82 acres, more or less, of State school land, located in San Bernardino and Inyo Counties, at a rental of \$441.32 per annum, beginning January 1, 1983.
- This assignment is exempt from CEQA because it is not a project.

Authority: P.R.C. 21065, 14 Gal. Adm. Code 15037 and 15060.

- 3. This assignment is for the use of land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1 and is classified in a use category Class "A" and "B", which authorizes Restrictive Use and Limited Use, respectively. Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing land use for which no adverse comments have been received.
- 4. The hease rental rate is \$2.36 per Animal Unit Month (AUM) and the carrying capacity for the assigned lands was estimated at 298 AUM's for a rental of \$703.28 per annum; the carrying capacity for the unassigned lands under the subject lease was estimated at 187 AUM's for a rental of \$441.32 per annum.
