OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The applicant requested and received on October 8, 1082, a letter of permission from State Lands Commission to enter onto State land to perform emergency bank protection work along 2,400 linear feet of the eroded riverbank in the Sacramento River, Tehama County, preceding a formal permit. Without the bank protection, area orchards would be inundated with the onset of high water and Fish and Game required that riverbed work be performed before October 15, 1982. Staff recommends that the processing fee be waived because the State's ownership is not clearly defined at this location.
- 2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$150.
- 3. This project is exempt from CEQA because it is a measure to prevent or mitigate an emergency, pursuant to 14 Cal. Adm. Code, Div. 6, Section 15071(c).
- 4. The project is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category "B" which authorizes Limited Use. The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.



AUTHORIZE LSSUANCE TO STATE RECLAMATION BOARD OF A 25-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT PUBLIC AGENCY USE, FROM OCTOBER 1, 1982; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR BANK PROTECTION AND STABILIZATION ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

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
