GRAZING LEASE

APPLICANT:

Benton Land and Cattle Company

Benton, California 93512

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 600^{+} acre parcel of State school land situated in Mono County.

LAND USE:

Livestock grazing.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period:

Ten years from October 1, 1982.

Special:

The number of animals 1. permitted on the leased land is restricted to those that can be supported by the available forage and water, taking into consideration forage and water reserved for necessary wildlife use. The available carrying capacity is estimated to average 13- animal unit months per year. However, the actual capacity may vary over the term of this lease due to climatic conditions or other natural phenomena.

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2. Lessee shall take all reasonable and necessary actions to prevent, suppress and control fires.

CONSIDERATION: \$25 per annum with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on the fifth anniversary of the lease.

BASIS FOR CONSTDERATION:

Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2003(a)(6). The estimated carrying capacity of the 600-acres is 13- animal unit months which at the rate of \$1.86 per animal unit month amounts to approximately \$25 per annum; the lease applicant offered \$25 per year as the rental for said school land.

Filing fee and the first year's annual rental have been received,

The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.
