DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT:

City of Petaluma P. O. Box 61 Petaluma, California 94953

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: Tide and submerged lands ir a turning basin in the Petaluma River in the City of Petaluma, Sonoma County.

Dredge over a ten-year period up to 100,000 LAND USE: cubic yards of accumulated material forming a sand bar in the turning basin. Spoils to be deposited in Corps of Engineers (C.O.E.) Disposal Site S.F. 10, San Pablo Bay.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT: For a period of ten years from Period: June 1, 1983.

Royalty requirements for spoils deposited the C.O.E. Site S.F. 10 will be waived CONSIDERATION: , consideration of the public ...efit to improve navigation and flood control capacity. A royalty of \$0.25 per cubic yard to be charged for spoils placed on private property or sold for commercial benefit.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: The filing fee has been received.

- 3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE CITY OF PETALUMA OF A TEN-YEAR DREDGING PERMIT FROM JUNE 1, 1983. NO ROYALTY IS TO BE CHARGED FOR SPOILS DISPOSED AF THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS DISPOSAL SITE S.F. 10 IN SAN PABLO BAY. A ROYALTY OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD IS TO BE CHARGED FOR SPOILS PLACED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY OR SOLD FOR COMMERCIAL BENEFIT.

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
