REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO
SETTLE NUMEROUS CONDEMNATION ACTIONS ALONG
STANISLAUS RIVER BY AGREEMENT TO
REVEST SOVEREIGN TITLE IN STATE AND FOR
STATE TO WAIVE COMPENSATION;
CALAVERAS, STANISLAUS, SAN JOAQUIN, AND
TUOLUMNE COUNTIES

In the years 1981, 1982 and 1983, numerous condemnation actions were brought by the foderal government to acquire interests in land along the Stanislaus Rivor between New Melones Dam and the confluence with the San Joaquin River. Although a few of these actions were to acquire a fee interest, the vast majority were for the purpose of securing easements for recreation access and water overflow.

The State of California was named in all of these condemnation lawsuits. The primary purpose of naming the State was to clear out any proprietary State interest, particularly that derived from transfers to the State due to private party failure to pay taxes. Since the descriptions in these condemnations included the bed of the Stanislaus River, a secondary effect of them may have been to take the sovereign interest of the State of California in the bed of the River. Federal representatives have informed the staff of the Commission that they had no desire to acquire State sovereign interests. A proposed settlement has been reached to avoid that possible consequence.

The staff of the State Lands Commission, the Office of the Attorney General, and representatives of the United States Army Corps of Engineers have agreed in principle to a settlement of all of these cases which would preserve the condition of title which existed before the condemnations were filed. The settlement as proposed has two operative parts:

- The United States will revest in the State of California any sovereign interests the United States may have taken by the filing of these condemnation actions; and
- 2. The State Lands Commission will disclaim any right to compensation for the federal acquisition of interests in those parts of the parcels which lie outside the sovereign bed of the Standslaus River. In each of the cases, the staff of the State Lands Commission has verified that no proprietary inverests such as those derived from school lands exist in the parcels to be taken.

The staff supports this settlement of all these cases in the manner described above. The settlements will maintain the State's title as it existed before the condemnations were filed and will enable the federal government to expeditiously proceed with the acquisition of public access easements along the river so that the public may enjoy the Stanislaus River downstream of New Melones Dam.

A list of the cases within the purview of chis Calendar Item is attached as Exhibit "A". The list is intended to be comprehensive. However, the staff requests the Commission to grant authority to settle all similar cases along the Stanislaus (even those which may not be in the list in Exhibit "A") according to the terms set forth above.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a statutory exempt project. The project is exempt because it involves settlements of title and boundary problems.

AUTHORIZE THE STAFF AND THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO SETTLE THOSE CASES LISTED IN EXHIBIT "A" AND ANY OTHER SIMILAR CASES ALONG THE STANISLAUS RIVER USING AN AGREEMENT WHICH WOULD REVEST SOVEREIGN TITLE IN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND CALL FOR THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION TO DISCLAIM COMPENSATION TO UPLANDS PROPERTIES WHERE NO PROPRIETARY RIGHTS SUCH AS DERIVED FROM SCHOOL LANDS EXISTS.
