OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. County of Glenn proposes to construct a public launching facility comprised of a cne-lane ramp, paved parking and access area, portable sanitary facilities, a boarding float and other ancillary facilities. The site is an existing unmaintained slough which provides a direct channel to the main river channel. Because staff has not performed study of that reach of the river, the state's ownership claim is undetermined. The lease terms provide that the State is leasing whatever right, title or interest it possesses; wherefore staff recommends that the processing expense fee be waived.
- 2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$25(1.00
- 3. A Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for this project by Glenn County. The State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document and believes that it complies with the requirements of the CEQA.
- 4. This activity involves lands identified as postessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. 
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
