TERMS: Initial period: Ten years.

Renewal options: None.

Filing fee: \$25 (all).

Processing fee: \$45 (all).

CONSIDERATION: No monetary consideration pursuant to Section 6503, P.R.C.

PREREQUISITE TERMS:

Applicants are littoral landowners as defined in Section 6503, P.R.C.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that these activities are exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as categorical exempt projects. These projects are exempt under Class 1 (existing facilities, Items No. A and C), 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(a)(2) and Class 3 (new construction, Item No. B), 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(c)(1).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

2. These activities involve lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the projects as proposed are consistent with the lands' use classification.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THESE ACTIVITIES ARE EXEMPT FROM CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061 AS CATEGORICAL EXEMPT PROJECTS, CLASS 1 (EXISTING FACILITIES, ITEMS NO. A AND C) 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2905(a)(2) AND CLASS 3 (NEW CONSTRUCTION, ITEM NO. B), 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2905(c)(1) AND FIND THAT THESE ACTIVITIES ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE USE CLASSIFICATION DESIGNATED FOR THE LAND PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370 ET SEQ.
2. AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF TEN YEAR RECREATIONAL PIER PERMITS TO THE APPLICANTS LISTED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
