bridge.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Staff received a notice from the State Reclamation Board in March 1984, regarding a proposed project by the Department of Transportation (DOT) to widen an existing bridge which crosses the Kings River near Laton in Kings County. No record of a permit for the bridge was found and, therefore, staff notified DOT of the need to obtain a permit under Section 101.5 of the Streets and Highways Code.

2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be approximately \$50.

3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Minor Alterations to Existing Facilities, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15301(e)(1).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084 and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

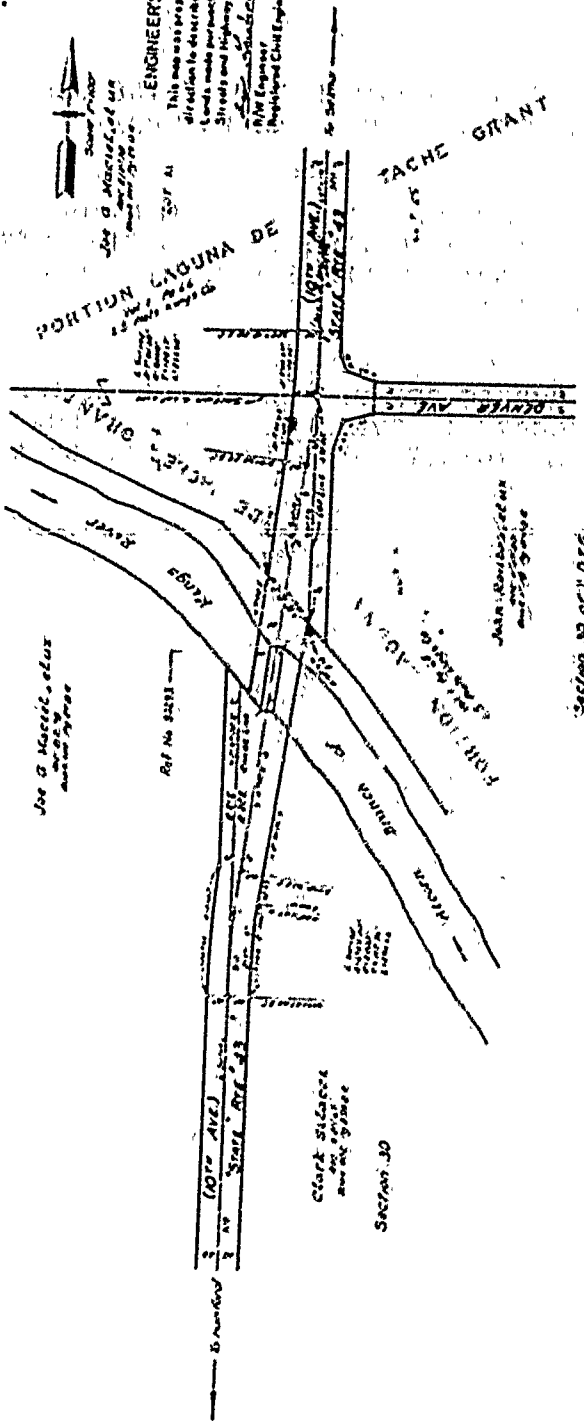

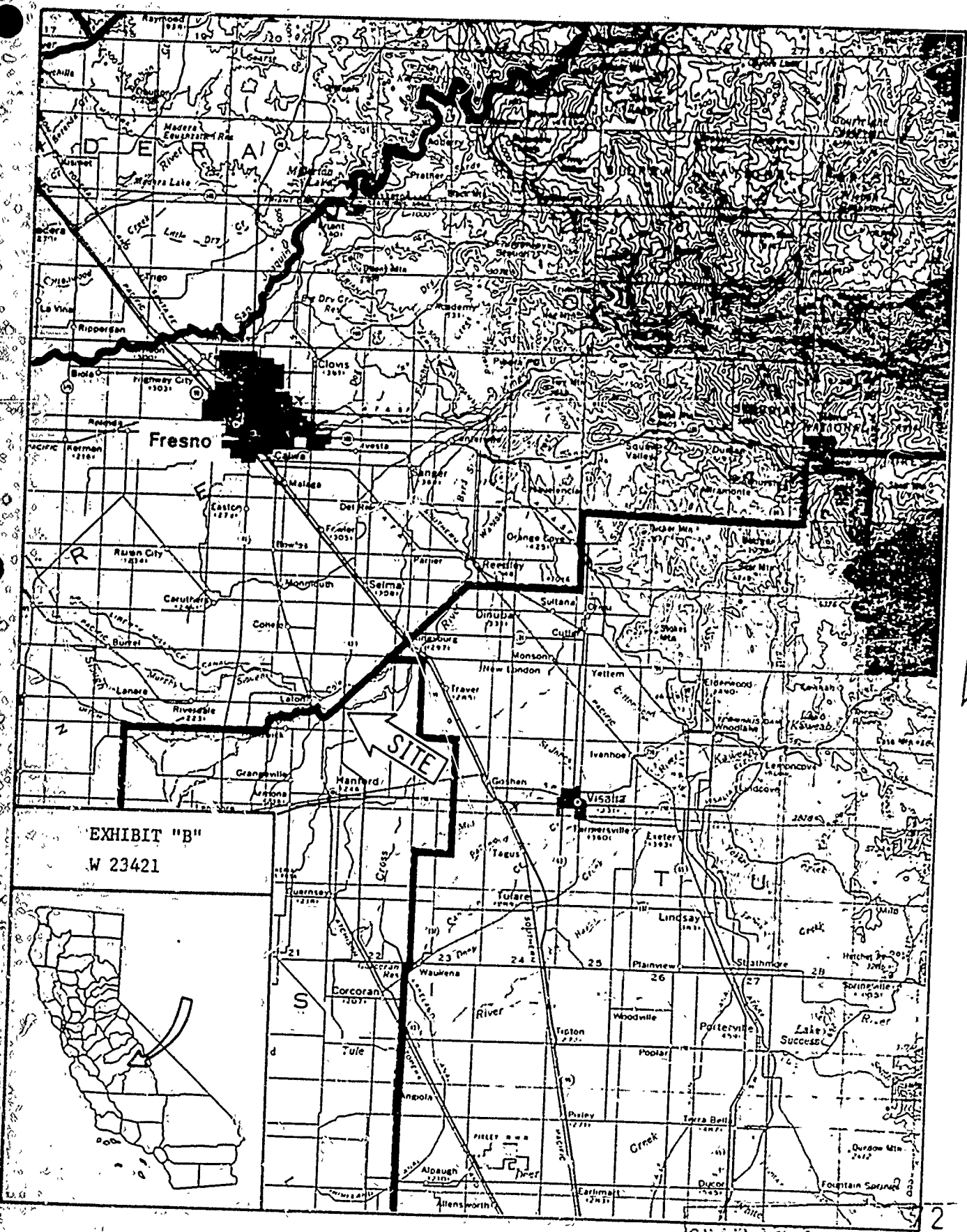
