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AUTHORIZATION TO INCLUDE IN THE LIST OF CRITERIA
FOR ANY COMMISSION PROGRAM THE CRITERION THAT A
REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT MAY BE REQUIRED

APPLICANT: State Lands Commission

When the Commission last revised and approved lists of criteria for submission of program applications, staff was authorized to require reimbursement agreements for environmental processing, when appropriate. However, the programs governed by the approved lists of criteria did not include all Commission programs available.

Because of the increasing costs of environmental review, it is felt that applicants for any Commission programs must be made aware of the need for reimbursement agreements. All lists of criteria for such programs should therefore include the provision that the execution of a reimbursement agreement may be a condition for a completed application.

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061 BECAUSE THE ACTIVITY IS NOT A PROJECT AS DEFINED BY P.R.C. 21065 AND 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15378.
2. DIRECT THE STAFF TO INCLUDE AS A CRITERION FOR ANY COMMISSION PROGRAM APPLICATION THE PROVISION THAT THE APPLICANT MAY BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE AN EXECUTED REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL PROCESSING.
