CALENDAR ITEM

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DENIAL OF APPLICATION CHARLES E. MADDUX

Current Law requires State agencies to compile lists of criteria specifying the detailed application information required of applicants for development projects. Accordingly, the State Lands Commission adopted its application criteria through Calendar Item 2 at its April 12, 1978 meeting.

Once an application has been accepted as complete, the Commission must act on the application vathin specified time periods. Failure to act within the time allowed, either by approving or denying the project, could result in approval of the project, as proposed.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. The project is exempt because GEQA does not apply to projects which a public agency rejects or disapproves.

The applicant has applied to State Lands Commission to purchase an access easement across State owned lands in order to obtain legal access to a landlocked parcel located within Lucerne Valley, San Bernardino During the course of negotiation it was datermined that a legally acceptable land survey map depicting the location of an existing desert road relative to the access easement strip would be required. Insufficient time remains within the specified time period to approve or disapprove this application for the applicant to obtain this cortification. The applicant has been informed of the proposed denial.
