- 2. Permitted prospecting activities include conducting fluid level measurements, logging of thermal fluctuations, and periodic sampling of well solutions (0.5 liter per sample) at three existing wells (drilled and capped by the applicant under a previous prospecting permit). During the term of the permit, activity has been mainly centered on the small scale pilot plant in adjacent section 25. Preliminary results indicate that solution borate mining is economically viable. However further work including filtration, washing and recrystallization process tests to produce boric acid crystals are planned.
- 3. Mountain States Mineral Enterprises, Inc. purchased all rights to the project from Duval Corporation in October 1985. Since Mountain States Mineral Enterprises, Inc. did not purchase the entirety of Duval Corporation's assets, an assignment of this permit is required. In addition to the assignment Mountain States Mineral Enterprises, Inc. also requests a che year extension of the mineral prospecting permit in order to determine the commerciality of the project.


