AWARD OF THE ROYALTY OIL SALES CONTRACT, STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE E-392, HUNTINGTON BEACH FIELD, ORANGE COUNTY

On January 22, 1987 the State Lands Commission authorized the sale of royalty crude oil from six State oil and gas Leases in the Huntington Beach and Belmont Offshore Fields, Orange County. State Oil and Gas Lease E-392, was one of the leases for which the Commission authorized the sale of royalty oil. The royalty oil contract for this lease expired on October 1, 1986. Edgington Oil Company was purchasing this oil and paying the State a bonus per barrel of \$0.724 above a Base Price equal to the highest price posted for like oil in the Huntington Beach Field. The State's share of production from this lease is approximately 19,000 barrels per month of 19° API gravity crude oil.

A Notice Inviting Bids was published in the <u>Orange County</u>

<u>Register</u> on February 23, 1987 and sent to all known interested parties. Bids were received and opened on March 9, 1987. Exhibit "A" shows the result of the bidding.

Fiscal and Legal reviews of the submitted bid material were done by the State Lands Commission Auditing and Legal Units respectively. Based on the results of the reviews, the highest responsible bidder has been #dentified on Exhibit "A". Staff recommends the awarding of the Royalty Oil Sales Contract for State Oil and Gas Lease E-392, Huntington Beach Field, Orange County to the highest responsible bidder identified on Exhibit "A" for the period beginning May 1, 1987 until November 1, 1987.
