FOURTH MODIFICATION OF THE 1987-1988
PLAN OF DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATIONS AND BUDGET
LONG BEACH UNIT, WILMINGTON OIL FIELD
LOS ANGELES COUNTY

The City of Long Beach has submitted to the Commission the Fourth Modification of the 1987-1988 Plan of Development and Operations and Budget, Long Beach Unit. The Fourth Modification provides for the transfer of funds within the budget into the Taxes, Permits, and Land Rental Program to provide for shortages anticipated in mining rights taxes and land rental expense.

Mining rights and property taxes of \$13 million paid to the County of Los Angeles, City of Long Beach and school and special districts, and \$2 million in business license tax paid to the City of Long Beach are almost 14% of this year's Unit expense. Mining rights taxes for the current year are about seven percent higher than staff estimated at the time the budget was prepared based on taxes for 1986-1987.

Land rentals of over \$1.3 million, paid almost exclusively to the City of Long Beach Harbor Department, will be approximately ten percent higher this budget year than budgeted.

Funds are available for transfer in the Oil and Gas and the Water Injection Programs.
