APPROVAL OF ADDENDUM NO. 14
TO PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY
MASTER LEASE PRC 6205

APPLICANT:

Pacific Gas & Electric Company

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 0.083-acre parcel of tide and submerged land,

Sacramento River, Tehama County.

LAND USE:

Overhead 12 KV electric pole line crossing.

BACKGROUND:

On August 26, 1982, Minute Item No. 19, the State Lands Commission approved a master lease to Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) for various energy distribution facilities located throughout the State. The master lease, as approved, listed 82 separate leases for inclusion into the original master lease. The master lease contemplates the addition, and occasional deletion, of crossings according to the needs of the day. The terms of the master lease are set out below.

TERMS OF MASTER LEASE:

Initial period:

30 years beginning

September 1, 1982.

Renewal options:

One successive period of

15 years.

Public liability insurance: Combined single

limit coverage of \$2,000,000 or alternative acceptable to the State Lands Commission.

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Consideration:

\$15,534 per annum; five-year

rent review.

CONSIDERATION:

Continuation of present rental.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2003.

CURRENT SITUATION:

Tehama County Road Department is replacing the Sacramento River Bridge along the Bend Ferry Road, approximately six miles northeast of Red Bluff. The Commission approved the new bridge construction on April 12, 1988, Item No. CO9. The existing overhead 12 KV line, which is not under State permit, will interfere with the new bridge replacement and the Applicant proposes to relocate it to the south side of the new bridge, with construction to begin on June 1, 1988.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of a Small Structure, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15303.

Authority: P.R.C. 21084 and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300.

 The annual rental of the site is estimated to be \$100, which is the minimum rental for this type of lease.

- 3. AUTHORIZE APPROVAL AND ISSUANCE TO PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY OF ADDENDUM NO. 14 TO MASTER LEASE PRC 6205 PROVIDING FOR THE PLACEMENT AND INSTALLATION OF A 12 KU OVERHEAD ELECTRIC LINE CROSSING SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A-14", ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

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
