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DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO AWARD CONTRACT TO THE LOWEST BIDDER  
FOR THE RENTAL OF GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM  
FOR THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER PROJECT

The Commission was provided with \$30,000 in the 1988-89 fiscal year to clarify land title in the area identified as the San Joaquin River Parkway which consists of a twenty-five mile reach of the river between Friant Dam and Highway 99 Bridge. Commission staff estimates that approximately 3,000 acres of State-owned, but yet unidentified, sovereign land exists within the area of the proposed parkway.

The work to be performed consists of mapping and monumenting approximately 65 miles of historic bank lines. Rental of a Global Positioning System (GPS) sufficient to do a complete geodetic control project of 100 stations will be required to efficiently and economically complete this work. The bid results are as follows:
