## AUTHORIZATION TO FILE A DISCLAIMER

The State Lands Commission is a party defendant to a condemnation action brought by the United States entitled United States of America $\cup 8.55$ Acres, More or Less, in the County of Kern, State of California, et al., Civil No. CU-7-88-320-EDP, filed in the United States District Court, Eastern District of California. The land is being acquired by the United States in connection with the construction and maintenance of the Pacific Crest National Scenic Trail.

Upon examination of the Commission's records pertinent to the area, it was ascertained by staff that Easements 1 and 2 cross lands the State never acquired or disposed of. Easement 3 crosses Section 9, T1ON, R15W, SBM, which the State never acquired or disposed of. Easement 3 also crosses Section 16. TION, R15W, SBM, which the State acquired and disposed of as school lands. No minerals were reserved on disposition. Based on this analysis, staff believes the State has no compensable interest and recommends that a disclaimer be filed with the court.
