AUTHORIZATION TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS, INCLUDING LITIGATION, TO REMOVE THE SUNKEN BARGE "NEPTUNE"

The barge "NEPTUNE" burned and sank in February 1987 in the Sacramento River near the City of Isleton. The barge had been moored near the site of the sinking for a number of years without a permit. The wreck, which is partially submerged, is a serious hazard to navigation and boating. Various other parties, including the City of Isleton, the Corp. of Engineers, and the Department of Boating and Waterways, are cooperating in an effort to remove this hazard. The Staff is requesting authority to take all necessary actions, including litigation, to have the hulk removed.
