Each of the applications herein are for the continued use of existing piers in the lake, and therefore are not subject to the Commission's suspension of leasing activities for new construction.
- 4. All permits covering structures in Lake Tahoe will include a condition subsequent that if any structure authorized is found to be in nonconformance with the
