**ASSIGNMENT OF LEASES PRC 778 AND PRC 2529
GENERAL LEASE - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE**

ASSIGNOR: Fibreboard Corporation
P.O. Box 4125
Concord, California 94524

ASSIGNEE: Gaylord Container Corporation
P.O. Box 10
Antioch, California 94509

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 0.09+-and 6.5+-acre parcels of tide and
submerged lands, located in the San Joaquin
River near Antioch, Contra Costa and Sacramento
counties.

LAND USE: Maintenance and use of water pipelines
associated with paper mill on adjacent upland
property.

TERMS OF LEASE PRC 778:
Initial period: 49 years beginning December 5,
1952.
Surety bond: \$1,000.
Consideration: \$50 for the entire lease
period.

TERMS OF LEASE PRC 2529:

Initial period: 49 years beginning
February 25, 1960.

Consideration: \$47.26 per annum.

EXHIBIT "A - 1"
LAND DESCRIPTION

PRC 778

A parcel of tide and submerged land in the San Joaquin River, Contra Costa County, California, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the ordinary high water mark of the San Joaquin River which bears North 565.65 feet and N 33° 41' E 20.74 feet, more or less, from a 1 in. iron pipe at the intersection of the east line of the 50 foot wide Fiberboard Products, Inc. R/W, referred to in the deed from Lester Robinson to Marble D. Keeney dated January 4, 1892, and recorded January 9, 1892, in Book 62 of Deeds, page 12, Records of Contra Costa County, with the north line of the A.T.&S.F. Railroad Company R/W; thence along the ordinary high water mark N 53° 01' 38"W 77.93 feet; thence North 50.79 feet to a point in the San Joaquin River having California Coordinate System of 1927, Zone 3 coordinates X = 1,620,078.57, Y = 556,327.21; thence S 56° 23'E 105.99 feet to a point with coordinates X = 1,620,165.93, Y = 556,267.20; thence S 33° 41'W 46.86 feet to the point of beginning.

The basis of bearings is the deed call of north for the east line of the Fiberboard Products, Inc. R/W.

PRC 2529.1

LAND DESCRIPTION

Two parcels of land located in the San Joaquin River, near Antioch, Contra Costa and Sacramento Counties, State of California, said parcels being more particularly described as follows:

PARCEL 1

BEGINNING at a point on the Ordinary High Water Mark of the left bank of the San Joaquin River, said point being N 59° 32' 10" E 512.49 feet and N 24° 47' 50" W 158.48 feet, more or less, from California Lands Commission Monument "Board 1947" and N 44° 43' 15" E 150.82 feet, more or less, from Station 4 as shown on the J.G. Barnard Plat entitled "Fibreboard Products Inc. - East Antioch - Parts of Sections 8,9,16 and 17, T2N R2E, MDM.", dated January 1948; thence N 24° 47' 50" W 2587.79 feet, more or less, to the Ordinary High Water Mark of the San Joaquin River, on the south bank of West Island; thence along said OHWM N 64° 29' 50" E 100.03 feet; thence S 24° 47' 50" E 2267.23 feet, S 65° 12' 10" W 24.82 feet, S 24° 47' 50" E 293.67 feet, more or less, to a point on said Ordinary High Water Mark; thence along said OHWM S 44° 43' 15" W 80.25 feet to the point of beginning.

PARCEL 2

A 100 foot strip of land being 50 feet on either side of a centerline described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Ordinary High Water Mark of the San Joaquin River on the north bank of West Island, said point being S 64° 29' 50" W 50.01 feet and N 24° 47' 50" W 903.33 feet, more or less, from the most northerly point in Parcel 1 above; thence continuing N 24° 47' 50" W 335.67 feet.

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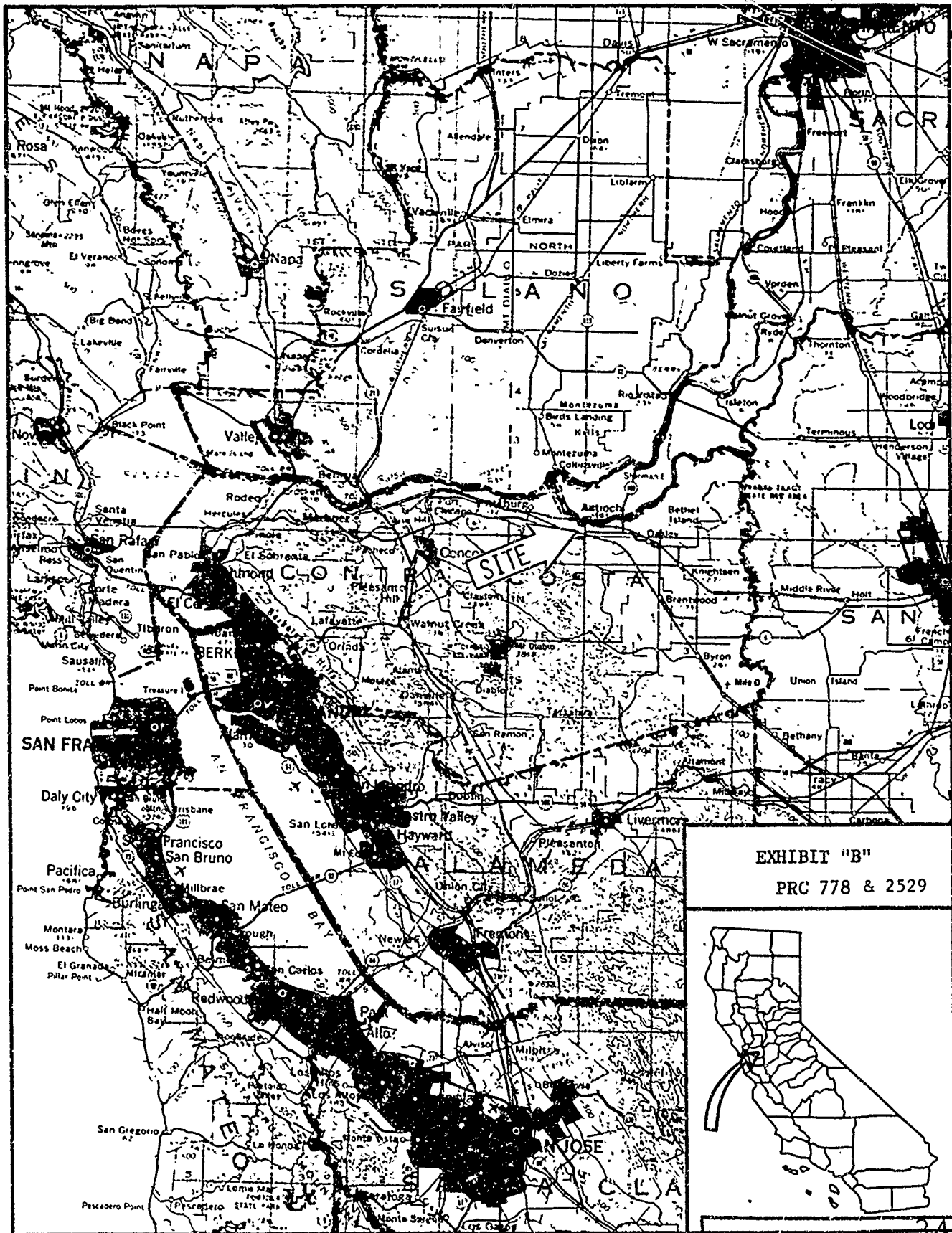
