



GENERAL PLAN FOR USE OF LAND LOCATED IN RIVERSIDE COUNTY

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has proposed the acquisition of a right-of-way covering a portion of the Red Canyon Trail as it crosses State school land identified as Section 16, Township 7 South, Range 13 East, SBM, covering 0.8 acres+ in Riverside County.

The acquisition of the right-of-way will have no direct impact on the property, because it is an existing road that is open for public use. The right-of-way is considered a part of the Red Canyon "Jeep" trail and has been approved under a State of California OHV Grant (OR-1-CD-33). There are no plans for major realignment or upgrading of the right-of-way.

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
