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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of a Small Structure.

Authority: P.R.C. 21084 and 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15300, and 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(c)(1).

In order to determine the other potential 2. trust uses in the area of the proposed project, the staff contacted representatives of the following agencies: TRPA, Department of Fish and Game, County of Placer, and Tahoe Conservancy. None of these agencies expressed a concern that the proposed project would have a significant effect on trust uses in the area. The agencies did not identify any trust néeds which were not being met by existing facilities in the Identified trust uses in this area would include swimming, boating, walking along the beach, and views of the lake. Staff made a physical inspection of the site and found that the proposed pier will have no significant impact on other Public Trust need in the immediate area.

There are numerous other piers on both sides of the proposed pier.

3. Staff has determined that the proposed project is not located in an area identified as prime fish habitat, fish spawning area, or a habitat restoration area, identified by the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency and the Department of Fish and Game.

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- 4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
- 5. All permits covering structures in Lake Tahoe will include a condition subsequent that if any structure authorized is found to be in nonconformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's shorezone ordinance and if any alterations, repairs, or removal required pursuant to said ordinance are not accomplished within the designated time period, then the permit will be automatically terminated, effective upon notice by the State, and the site shall be cleared pursuant to the terms thereof.

Tahoe Regional Planning Agency, United States Army Corps of Engineers, Lahontan Regional Water Quality Board, and Department of Fish and Game.


