DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY TO AWARD CONTRACT TO THE  
LOWEST BIDDER FOR HIRING A REAL PROPERTY  
INVESTMENT CONSULTANT FOR THE  
SCHOOL LAND MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

APPLICANT: State Lands Commission

At the December 13, 1988 meeting, the Commission approved the solicitation of bids for a real property investment consultant to analyze and recommend transactions to the Commission. Candidate transactions will include investments of School Land Bank Fund monies, and land exchanges, selections, and sales. Five bids were received on January 31, 1989 and have been evaluated. Two were judged as not qualifying, and the bids of three were opened. A successful bidder has been selected. The bids of those qualified by the two-tier evaluation process are as follows:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15061 BECAUSE THE ACTIVITY IS NOT A PROJECT AS DEFINED BY P.R.C. 21065 AND 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15378.

AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO AWARD AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH THE LOWEST QUALIFIED BIDDER, WILLIAMS, KUEBELBECK AND ASSOCIATES, INC., OF CITY OF BELMONT, CALIFORNIA, WHICH SUBMITTED THE LOWEST BID OF \$7,492 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADVISING THE COMMISSION ON REAL PROPERTY ACQUISITIONS.

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
