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#### EXHIBIT "A"

PÁRTICIFATING AGREEMENT BETWEEN CALIFORNIA STATE LANDS COMMISS ON AND

SHASTA-TRINITY NATIONAL FOREST
PACIFIC SOUTHWEST REGION
FOREST SERVICE, U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

This Participating Agreement by and between, the California State Lands Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "State" and the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service, Pacífic Southwest Region, hereinafter referred to as "Forest Service" under provisions of Public Law 94-148 (16 U.S.C. 565). Designated official representative for the State shall be Don Reese, Senior Land Agent and for the Forest Service shall be Ron Cecchi, North Zone Landownership Adjustment Team Leader.

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of the Act of March 20, 1922, as amended, and the Act of October 21, 1976, the Secretary of Agriculture is authorized to enter into land exchange negotiations to acquire State lands for inclusion in the National Forest System; and

WHEREAS, the Forest Service desires acquisition of certain lands owned and offered for exchange by the State described in "Exhibit I", attached hereto and made part hereof, and

WHEREAS, the State desires acquisition through exchange of certain National Forest System lands described in "Exhibit [I", attached hereto and made a part hereof, and

WHEREAS, both parties have a mutual interest in accomplishing the proposed land exchange which will provide a benefit to the public and to the State, and

WHEREAS, both parties agree to cooperatively finance the real property appraisals, and further agree that the purpose of this Participating Agreement addresses only the appraisal aspect of the proposed exchange. Both Parties recognize the benefits of jointly undertaking this work, because of the efficiency and economic advantages of cooperating in this effort rather than each party independently acquiring appraisals.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. Specifications for Bid Invitation shall be reviewed and approved by the State and the Forest Service prior to solicitation for bid.
- The third-party appraisal contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder acceptable to both parties. Bidding will be restricted to those firms mutually agreed upon by the Parties.
- 3. The State shall contract and pay costs to obtain appraisals for both the federal and nonfederal lands. The appraisal contract shall allow for progress payments with a ten percent (10%) retention to be held until the completion of the contract. Upon completion of each phase of the appraisal, the appraiser will submit an invoice and documentation in accordance with

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the Specifications of that contract. The Forest Service and the State shall jointly review and approve payments to the appraiser. The State shall submit an invoice to the Forest Service for payment of their prorata share of the appraisal cost(s). The Forest Service prorata share shall be based on the costs to perform contracted services for federal lands only and shall not exceed \$60.000 (sixty thousand dollars).

- 4. Farties shall obtain timber cruises and appraisals covering the subject federal and nonfederal lands in the subject proposed exchange, ar \*escribed in Exhibits I and II. Timber Cruises must meet Forest Service standards and format and final appraisals establishing fair market value must be pursuant to "Uniform Appraisal Standards for Federal Land Acquisitions, 1973", and appraisals follow the review process for Forest Service approval.
- 5. Forest Service and the State shall jointly approve selection of land or timber appraiser prior to contracting for services.
- 6. Farties agree that commercial timber exists on the federal and/or nonfederal lands and agree to accept the completed timber cruise data.
- 7. This agreement or any supplement thereto may be terminated by either party by providing 30 days written notice to the other. In the event of such termination, incurred costs and benefits of both parties will be summarized, and reconciled through payment or otherwise, such that each party's benefits are proportional to its contribution. Unless terminated by written notice, this agreement will remain in full force and effect through June 30, 1990.
- 8. Nothing herein shall be construed as obligating the Forest Service to expend funds or as involving the United States in any contract or other obligation for the future payment of money in excess of appropriations authorized by law and administratively allocated for the work contemplated in this agreement.
- 9. No member of or delegation to Congress or resident Commissioner shall be admitted to any share or part of this agreement or to any benefit that may arise therefrom unless it is made with a corporation for its general benefit.
