#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- A Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for this project by City/County of San Francisco. The State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document and believes that it complies with the requirements of the CEQA.
- 2. The permit provides that all improvements and structures within Lake Merced, north and south, except for that part of said lake within Rancho Laguna de la Merced, are subject to the permit jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission, but that there has been no final determination of the westerly boundary of the Rancho at the lake.
- 3. For the sake of efficient lease administration, the permit additionally provides, pending a final determination of the location of the westerly boundary of the Rancho, and without limiting or deciding upon the extent of the State's sovereign interest within Lake Merced, that the fishing pier designated as site "F" on the City's Negative Declaration, and a small bridge structure lying easterly of site "F", may both be retained, altered, or removed at the Permittee's discretion without involvement by the Lands Commission. The City has also agreed to provide and maintain waste receptacles at each pier site.
- 4. The Applicant has requested a waiver of the \$450 minimum expense deposit on the grounds that the project improvements will be serving and benefitting a broad segment of the general public, and not just the citizens of the City and County of San Francisco. Staff agrees with the Applicant and believes that a waiver of the fee is appropriate.




