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AUTHORIZATION, AS BOTH STATE LANDS COMMISSION  
AND SCHOOL LAND BANK TRUSTEE, TO SELL AN  
80-ACRE PARCEL OF STATE SCHOOL LAND  
IN SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY

APPLICANT: State Lands Commission

Pursuant to P.R.C. 8700 (School Land Bank Act) and a recent School Land Management Study, staff is in the process of identifying parcels of land that are scattered throughout the State and which, in their present condition, are either an uneconomic unit or are difficult to manage.

The subject property, located approximately seven miles southeast of Santa Margarita in San Luis Obispo County, consists of 80 acres of State school land acquired in an exchange with the Federal Government in 1969. The property with steep, brush laden hillsides contains rocky and poor soil. There are almost no open areas of vegetation for livestock grazing. A small, seasonal creek that empties into the Salinas River traverses the property. There is no recorded access for roads and utilities to serve the property and current zoning is Rural/Agricultural. A mineral evaluation found that the property has a low potential for the accumulation of mineral resources.

It is proposed that the Commission authorize the staff to offer the subject property for sale by competitive bid. The minimum bid for the property will be the appraised value of \$55,600 plus appraisal costs of \$2,000.

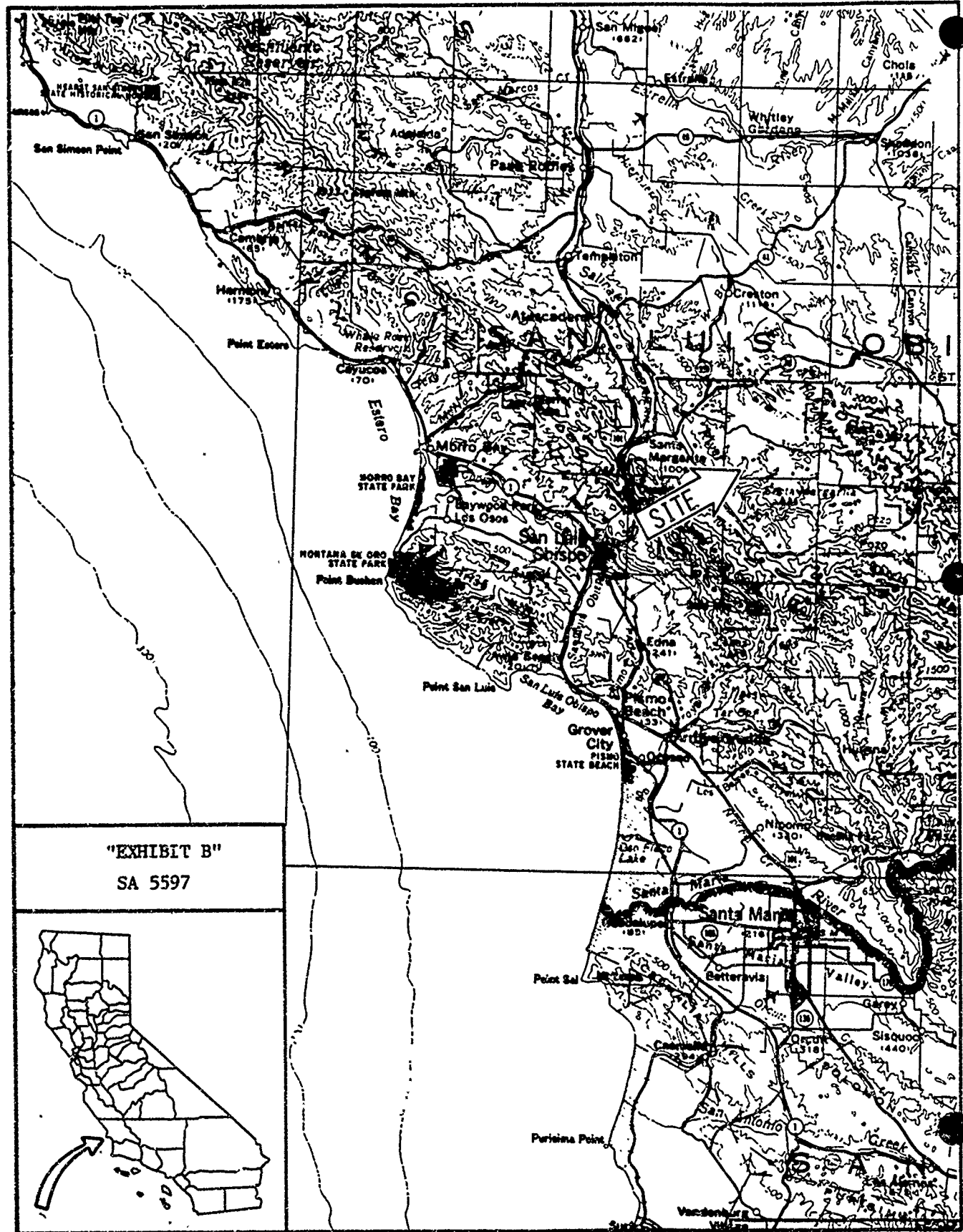
Two (2) parcels of California State school lands in San Luis Obispo County, California, described as follows.
