GENERAL PERMIT - RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANT: Thacher Threlkeld, John Handlin Threlkeld, Jr.,
Donald Pierce Crocket and
William Alexander Crocket, Jr.
c/o C & T Properties
445 West Dakota, #101
Fresno, California 93705

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 0.103-acre parcel of submerged land located
in Lake Tahoe near Kings Beach, Placer County.

LAND USE: Maintenance of an existing pier utilized for
recreational boating.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Initial period: Five-years beginning April 1,
1989.

Public liability insurance: Combined single
limit coverage of \$500,000.

Special:

1. The permit is conditioned on permittee's conformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone Ordinance.
2. The permit restricts any residential use of the facilities.
3. The permit conforms to the Lyon/Fogerty decision.

1. This is an application to replace an expired permit previously issued to Applicant.
2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities, 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2905(a)(2).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15300, and 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2905.
3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the activity is consistent with its use classification.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary low water mark of Lake Tahoe.

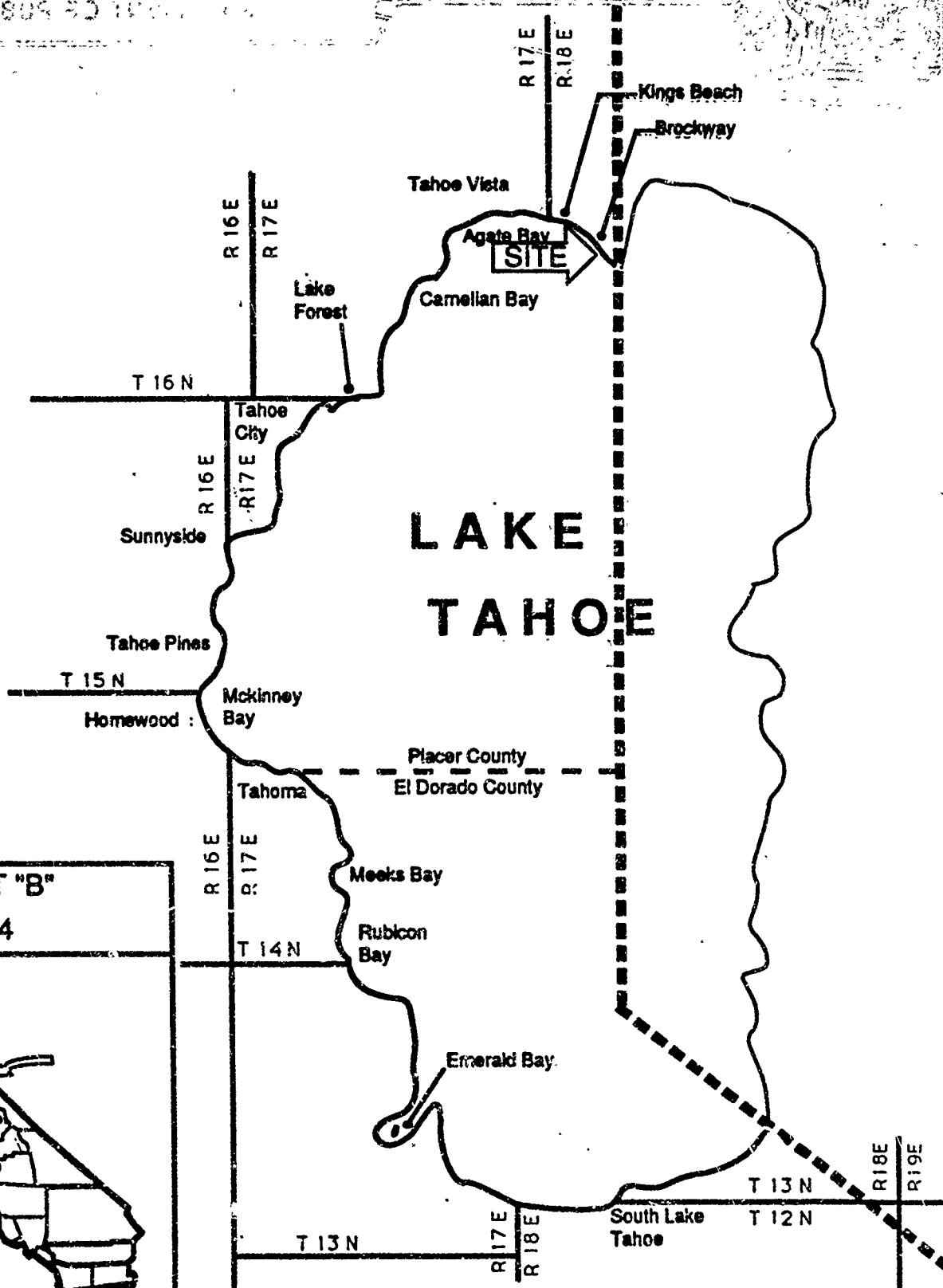
