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AWARD OF THE ROYALTY OIL SALES CONTRACT,  
STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE PRC 186, BELMONT  
OFFSHORE FIELD, ORANGE COUNTY

BACKGROUND

At its meeting on September 27, 1989, the State Lands Commission authorized the sale of royalty crude oil from several State oil and gas leases in Ventura and Orange counties, including State oil and gas lease PRC 186, Belmont Offshore Field, Orange County. Presently, the State is being paid in money for its share of the crude oil from this lease by the lessee.

The State's share of production from this lease is approximately 6,500 barrels per month of 19.5° API gravity crude oil. Royalty oil from this lease may be taken in kind of returned to the lessee on demand.

A Notice Inviting Bids for the new royalty oil sales contract to run from January 1, 1990 until July 1, 1991 was published in The Orange County Register on November 2, 1989. Bids were received and opened on November 21, 1989. The results of the bidding are contained in Exhibit "A".

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS

Fiscal and legal reviews of the submitted bid material were completed by the SLC Auditing and Legal units, respectively. The highest responsible bidder, as indicated by these reviews, has been identified in Exhibit "A".

Staff recommends awarding the new royalty oil sales contract for the period of January 1, 1990 until July 1, 1991 for State oil and gas lease PRC 186, Belmont Offshore Field, Orange County, to the highest responsible bidder identified in Exhibit "A".
