- 1. The original permit required payment of a royalty of \$0.25 per cubic yard for aquatic disposal. Under the proposed amendment, there will be no royalty charge. However, the "additional fee" charge of \$0.25 per cubic yard will remain in effect.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEGA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that his activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEGA under the general rule that CEGA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The staff believes there is no possibility that this project may have a significant effect on the environment.
