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DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT:

Fleur du Lac Estatas Association

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe at the entrance to

Fleur du Lac Marina, Placer County.

LAND USE:

Dredge a maximum 300 cubic yards of material to create a water inlet channel through the sand and gravel berm blocking the entrance channel to the marina harbor to maintain the water level as a fire protection-needed source. The dredged material will be dried at the adjacent upland, using methods specified by the Lahontan Water

Quality Control Board and, in the spring, disposed of at the Truckee public land fill site as approved by the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency and the Lahontan Regional Water Quality Control

Board.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period:

Surety bond:

One (1) year beginning December 12, 1990.

\$2,000.

Representatives of the State Lands Commission or Lahontan Regional Water Quality Control Board shall be on site during the entire dredging and disposal-related activities.

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CONSIDERATION:

\$0.25 per cubic yard.

- 1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15061 AS A CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT PROJECT, CLASS 4(g), MAINTENANCE DREDGING, 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 14104.
- AUTHORIZE STAFF TO ISSUE TO THE FLEUR DE LAC ESTATES ASSOCIATION THE DREDGING PERMIT AUTHORIZING DREDGING A MAXIMUM VOLUME OF 300 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL TO MAINTAIN A DEPTH AUTHORIZED BY THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS FOR ONE YEAR COMMENCING DECEMBER 12, 1990 FROM LAKE TAHOE AT THE ENTRANCE TO FLEUR DU LAC MARINA, PLACER COUNTY, AND DISPOSAL FOR DREDGING AT THE ADJACENT UPLAND, USING METHODS SPECIFIED BY LAHONTAN WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, AND EVENTUAL DISPOSAL AT THE TRUCKEE LANDFILL SITE APPROVED BY THE TAHOE REGIONAL PLANNING AGENCY AND THE REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD. A ROYALTY OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED FOR MATERIAL PLACED AT THE APPROVED DISPOSAL SITE. SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.
