Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that his activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land, 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15304.

- 2. The Applicant is proposing to install rock slope protection on the embankment between Highway 1 and the Navarro River approximately ten miles south of the town of Mendocino. The project was initiated as a result of recurrent landslides in the area and will protect the highway from further erosion.
- 3. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$819.72.
- 4. This amended map will increase the permit area from 3.6 acres to 4.554 acres.
