#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. In accordance with the terms and conditions of the existing lease PRC 3125, Mobil has provided notice to staff of its desire to exercise the second renewal option of ten (10) years, beginning May 15, 1989, for the continued use and maintenance of an existing pier located on tide and submerged land in the Rincon Field in the Santa Barbara Channel, Ventura County. There are six oil and gas wells located on the pier in the subject lease area, as well as other pipelines. The wells are slant-drilled to adjacent State oil and gas lease PRC 427.

In addition to incorporating present-day leasing requirements, the proposed lease agreement (on file in the offices of the State Lands Commission) amends the lease to provide for the following:

(a) Comprehensive public liability insurance covering the Lease Premises shall be amended to provide for limits of not less than \$2,000,000 combined singlé limit coverage.

(b) The amount of the surety bond shall be amended to \$500,000.

(c) Within 180 days of the Commission's action on this item, Mobil shall undertake a systems safety review and analysis of the operations on lease PRC 3125 to determine risks to the public which might result from an accident on this lease. The analysis shall consider fire, explosion, the release of toxic substances and other accidents which might occur as a result of Mobil's operations on this lease. The analysis shall define a hazard footprint for the facility, the probabilities of risk to the general public, the consequences associated with such accidents, the measures which can eliminate or reduce the risks and/or consequences. The study plan for this

analysis shall be submitted to the staff of the Commission for its review and approval. The results of the study shall also be reviewed and approved by the staff of the Commission.

(d) Upon approval of the systems safety review and analysis, Mobil shall prepare, within 180 days of said approval, an emergency response plan for their operations on lease PRC 3125. This emergency response plan shall integrate to the maximum extent possible the requirements and response actions detailed in the critical operations and curtailment plan and the oil spill response plan for State oil and gas lease PRC 427. The emergency response plan shall be subject to the review and approval of the Commission.

- 2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that his activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities, 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2905(a)(2).




