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
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GENERAL LEASE - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE

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GENERAL LEASE - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE

Union Oil Company of California APPLICANT: P. Q. Box 7600 Los Angeles, California 90051

A 0.184-acre parcel of sovereign tide and submerged land, AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: Old River, Union Island, Contra Costa and San Joaquin counties.

Construction and maintenance of a 12-inch natural gas LAND USE: pipeline.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE Thirty (30) years beginning February 7, 1991. Initial period:

Surety bond: \$5,000.

Public liability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of \$100,000.

\$100 per annum; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease. CONSIDERATION:

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION: Pursuant to 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2003.

APPLICANT STATUS:

Applicant is lessee of upland.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Filing fee has been received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. An EIR (SCH NO. 8902715) was prepared and adopted for this project by the county of Contra Costa. The State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document.
- 2. The EIR identified a significant adverse impact to 0.3 acres of riparian habitat at the Old River crossing. This impact was not mitigated. instead, Contra Costa County adopted a Statement of Overriding Considerations. Apparently, this course was chosen because of a requirement by Reclamation district 2 to riprap the trench as an erosion protection measure.
- 3. The Old River is identified as a use category B (Limited Use) in the State Lands Commission "Inventory of Uncoveyed State School Lands and Tide and Submarged Lands Possessing Significant Environmental Values". This designation allows limited use compatible with and non-consumptive of the significant environmental values present, including riparian habitat. California Administrative Code sections 2953 and 2954 govern the State Lands Commission's use of the Significant Lands Inventory. Section 2954 precludes the Commission from adopting a Statement of Overriding Considerations for this project.

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CALENDAR ITEN NO. 20 (CONT'D)

- 4. The project's impacts to riparian habitat can be mitigated and the applicant has agreed to do so pursuant to the special conditions which will attach to the proposed general permit. These conditions are listed in Exhibit "D" attached hereto.
- 5. The State Lands Commission's staff attempted to find a site revegetation option that would mitigate the impacts in the construction zone. Unfortunately, the use of matting in-lieu of armor rock and planting between the armor rock were not acceptable to Reclamation District 2. The District is willing, however, to accept planting elsewhere in the project vicinity. Because the revegetation will not take place at the exact site of disturbance, mitigation will occur at a 2 to 1 ratio. Thus, 0.6 acre of riparian habitat will be established to compensate for the 0.3 acre destroyed.

Contra Costa County, United States Army Corps of Engineers, and Reclamation District 2.

Department of Water Resources and Department of Fish and Game.

- 1. FIND THAT AN EIR (SCH NO. 8902715) WAS PREPARED AND ADOPTED FOR THIS PROJECT BY THE COUNTY OF CONTRA COSTA AND THAT THE COMMISSION HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION CONTAINED THEREIN.
- 2. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT, AS AMENDED AND APPROVED, WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.



3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO UNOCAL - REAL ESTATE DIVISION OF A THIRTY-YEAR GENERAL LEASE - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE BEGINNING FEBRUARY 7, 1991 WITH SPECIAL CONDITIONS (EXHIBIT "D"); IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LEASE; PROVISION OF A \$5,000 SURETY BOND; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$100,000; FOR LOCATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A 12-INCH NATURAL GAS PIPELINE AND ROCK RIPRAP ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

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
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


Exhibit D

Special Conditions

Within 30 days of permit approval, the applicant shall submit to the staff of the State Lands Commission, for their review and approval, a site revegetation plan incorporating the following elements:

- A. The designation of species native to the area as selected by a qualified biologist of plani ecologist.
- B. The planting, with such species, of an area of at least 0.6 acres located: 1) in close proximity to the area of disturbance and; 2) where there will be no interference with pipeline project erosion control measures and district levee maintenance activities. Reclamation District 2 staff shall have approved such plan prior to submittal to State Lands Commission staff.
- C. A schedule for planting during spring of 1991.
- D. Monitoring sufficient to assure success of plantings and consistent with or incorporated into the mitigation monitoring plan developed for the balance of the project (Environmental Compliance Monitoring for the Union Island to Richmond Natural Gas Pipeline by Woodward-Clyde Consultants, October, 1990.)

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
