DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICALT:

Dean and Gale Leatherman 401 W. Willow Tree Lane Isleton, California 95641

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River at Andrus Island, Sacramento County.

LAND USE:

Construction of two floating docks and dredge a maximum of 20 cubic yards of material to maintain a navigable depth. The material will be disposed of permanently on the adjacent upland which is owned by the Applicant.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial pariod:

Facility: Ten (10) years beginning April 3, 1991

Dredging: One (1) year beginning April 3, 1991.

Royalty:

\$0.25 per cubic yard for material dredged and disposed of as approved.

COMPIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Section 6503, P.R.C., as to the Recreational Pier Permit.

PASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Pursuant to 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2003.

APPLICANT STATUS:

Applicant is owner of upland.

Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The facilities to be constructed are exempt under Class 3, New Construction, 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2905. The dredging is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land, 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15104.

 MAXIMUM 20 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM THE SACRAMENTO RIVER
 AT ANDRUS ISLAND, SACRAMENTO COUNTY, TO MAINTAIN A NAVIGABLE
 DEPTH. THE DREDGED MATERIAL WILL BE DISPOSED OF PERMANENTLY
 ON THE ADJACENT UPLAND WHICH IS OWNED BY THE APPLICANT. A
 ROYALTY OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED FOR
 MATERIAL DREDGED AND DISPOSED OF AS APPROVED. THE PERMITTED
 ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON THE APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH
 APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, AND LIMITATIONS ISSUED
 BY FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.

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
