#### BACKGROUND:

State oil and gas lease PRC 186 was issued to Marine Exploration Company on September 24, 1945. It consists of approximately 1,225 acres of tide and submerged land located within the Belmont Offshore Field, Orange County. Through a series of assignments and name changes, Texaco, Inc. and Exxon Company, U.S.A., each own an undivided 50 percent interest in the lease. Now, Texaco, Inc. proposes to assign its undivided 50 percent interest in the lease to Texaco Exploration and Production, Inc.

Lease Paragraph No. 4 provides that the Lessee, with Commission approval, may assign any portion of the lease to a corporation that possesses the qualifications within P.R.C. 6801. The lease also specifies that the assignment will take effect on the first day of the month following Commission approval.

In documents filed on May 13, 1991 Texaco, Inc. has requested Commission approval to assign its undivided 50 percent interest in this lease to its successor-in-interest, Texaco Exploration and Troduction, Inc. Staff has reviewed the documents and lease

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
