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APPROVE A GENERAL PERMIT - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE
FOR AN INDEFINITE TERM

APPLICANT:

Pacific Bell

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 0.01-acre parcel of submerged land in the Cosumnes River
at State Highway 16, Sacramento County.

LAND USE:

Aerial telephone cable crossing.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period:
Indefinite, beginning April 1, 1992.

CONSIDERATION:

Exempt per Section 7901 of the Public Utilities Code.

APPLICANT STATUS:

Applicant is permittee of the State Department of
Transportation; Pacific Bell project within Highway 16 right-
of-way.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing fee and processing costs have been received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The project is an aerial crossing of the Cosumnes River by a telephone cable and will not entail the use of construction equipment or require a physical structure within the bed of the river.
2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land, 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15304.

Authority: P.R.C. 21084 and 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15300.

3. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100.
4. The activity is exempt from local government approval pursuant to Section 7901, Public Utilities Code.

APPROVALS OBTAINED:

State Reclamation Board and State Department of Transportation.

FURTHER APPROVALS REQUIRED:

State Lands Commission.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15061 AS A CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT PROJECT, CLASS 4, MINOR ALTERATION TO LAND, 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15304 AND P.R.C. 21034.
2. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO PACIFIC BELL OF A GENERAL PERMIT - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE FOR AN INDEFINITE TERM FOR THE PLACEMENT AND INSTALLATION OF AN AERIAL TELEPHONE CABLE OVER THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

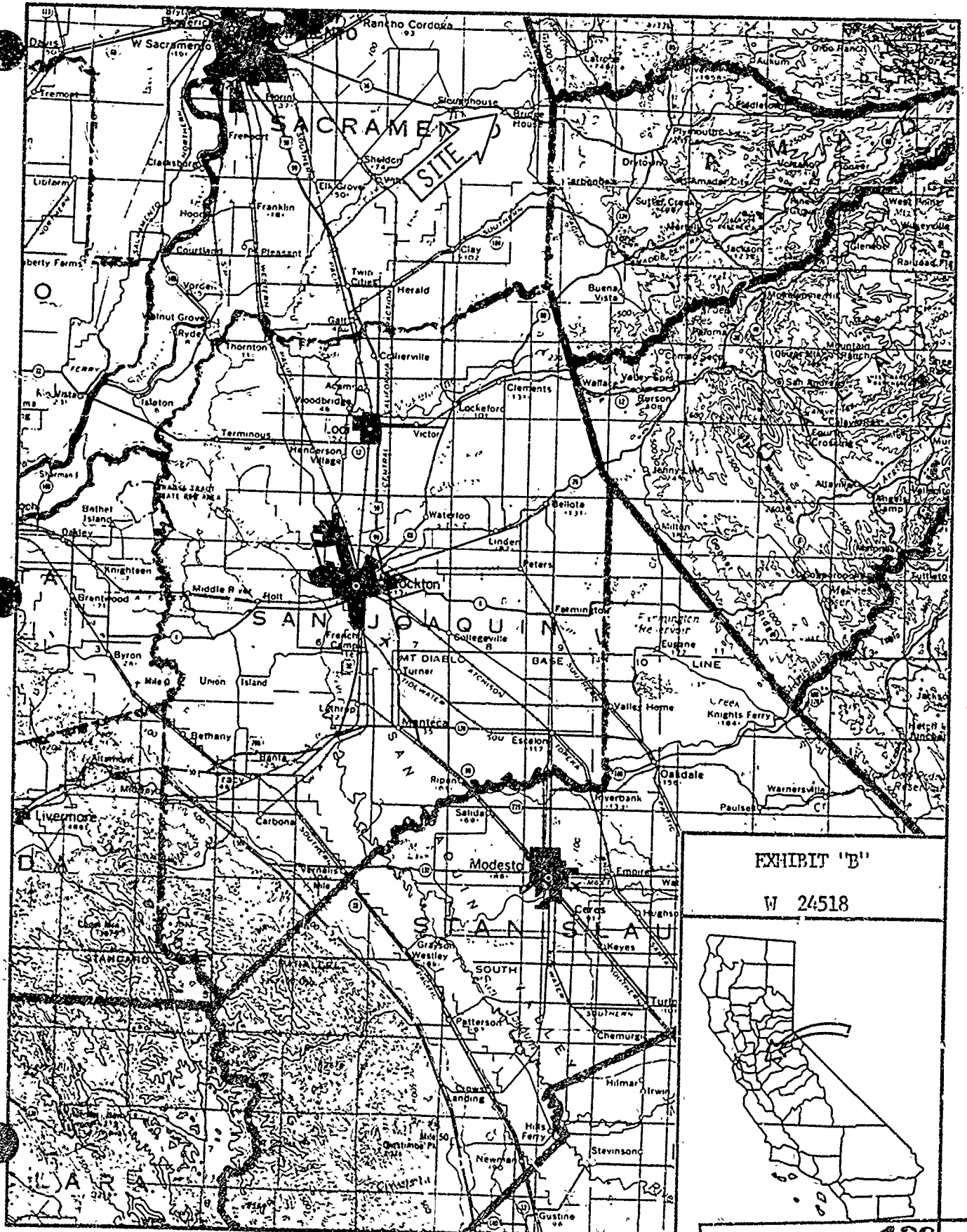
