# OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities, 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2905(a)(2).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15300, and 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2905.

- 2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
- 3. Rorippa subumbellata No materials will be stored or placed, nor will any activity associated with the construction or maintenance of the project be conducted, above the low water line (elevation 6,223 feet, Lake Tahoe Datum [L.T.D.]) of the subject property. This procedure will prevent any disturbance to the habitat of Rorippa subumbellata, commonly called the Tahoe Yellow Cress, a State-listed endangered plant species.

The permit includes specific provisions by which the Permittee agrees to protect and replace or restore, if required, the Rorippa habitat.

- 4. The permit is conditioned on the public's right of access along the shorezone below the high water line (elevation 6,228.75 feet, Lake Tahoe Datum), pursuant to the holding in <a href="State">State</a> v. <a href="Superior Court">Superior Court</a> (Fogerty), 2 Cal.3d 240 (1981), and provides that the Permittee must provide a reasonable means for public passage along the shorezone, including, but not limited to, the area occupied by the authorized improvements.
- 5. This subject property was physically inspected by staff for purposes of evaluating the impact of the proposed activity on the Public Trust.

- 2. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO CALIFORNIA GAS SERVICE COMPANY OF A FIVE-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT RECREATIONAL USE, BEGINNING MARCH 1, 1992; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$642; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$500,000, FOR THE CONTINUED USE AND MAINTENANCE OF AN EXISTING PIER AND THREE (3) MOORING BUOYS ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

## LAND DESCRIPTION

Four parcels of land in Lake Tahoe, Placer County, State of California, more particularly described as follows:

# PARCEL 1 - Pier

A parcel of land lying immediately beneath a pier, TOGETHER WITH the necessary use area extending 10 feet beyond its extremities, said pier being adjacent to that land described in that certain deed recorded January 17, 1973 in Volume 1467, page 546, in the Official Records of Placer County.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary low water mark of Lake Tahoe.

# PARCELS 2-4 - Buoys

Three circular parcels of land, each having a diameter of 40 feet, said parcels lying easterly and southeasterly of the above mentioned pier.
