ACCEPT QUITCLAIM DEEDS OF
STATE OIL & GAS LEASES PRC 3742, PRC 3895 AND PRC 3998
SUISUN BAY, SOLANO COUNTY

LESSEE:

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

State oil and gas lease PRC 3742 contains 3,489 acres of
tide and submerged lands in Suisun Bay, Solano County.

State oil and gas lease PRC 3895 contains 638 acres of tide
and submerged lands in Suisun Bay, Solano County.

State oil and gas lease PRC 3998 contains 1,720 acres of
tide and submerged lands in Solano County.

LEASE INFORMATION:

Competitive bid State oil and gas lease PRC 3742 was awarded to
Standard Oil Company of California (now Chevron U.S.A. Inc.) on
April 10, 1967, for a bonus bid of \$725,612.00.

Competitive bid State oil and gas lease PRC 3895 was awarded to
Standard Oil Company of California (now Chevron U.S.A. Inc.) and
Shell Oil Company on 12/12/67 for a bonus bid of \$72,164.18.
Shell Oil Company (now Shell Western E&P Inc.) assigned its
undivided one-half interest to Chevron U.S.A. Inc. on
September 27, 1989.

CALENDAR ITEM NO. 57 (CONT'D)

Competitive bid State oil and gas lease PRC 3998 was awarded to Standard Oil Company of California (now Chevron U.S.A. Inc.) on July 17, 1968 for a bonus bid of \$27,040.00.

BACKGROUND:

P.R.C. 6804.1 and paragraph 27 of each lease provide that the Lessee may make at any time a written quitclaim of all rights under the lease or of any portion of the leased lands comprising a ten-acre parcel or multiple thereof in a compact form. The quitclaim will be effective when it is filed with the State subject to the continued obligation of the Lessee and its surety to pay all accrued rentals and royalties and to abandon all wells drilled on the leased lands.

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. filed at the Commission's Long Beach office the Quitclaim Deeds for State oil and gas leases PRC 3742 and PRC 3998 on May 19, 1992, and for PRC 3895 on May 14, 1992. The quitclaim documents are dated May 5, 1992 and quitclaim to the State all of the Lessee's right, title, and interest in and to the leased lands described in exhibits "A", "B", and "C" of State oil and gas leases PRC 3742, PRC 3895 and PRC 3998, respectively. Two exploratory wells were drilled into lease PRC 3742 and one exploratory well was drilled on lease PRC 3998 without encountering commercial production. The wells have been abandoned pursuant to rules and regulations of the State Lands Commission and the Division of Oil and Gas (D.O.G.).

A review of the Commission's files reveals that no default exists on the leases, that the Lessee has complied with all applicable laws and lease provisions and has paid all rentals (no royalty is due as the leased lands were not productive).

1. All wells drilled into State lands were abandoned in accordance with D.O.G. standards.

(LESSEE) THE (FULL) QUITCLAIM DEEDS FOR STATE OIL AND GAS LEASES PRC 3742, PRC 3895, AND PRC 3998, EACH DATED MAY 5, 1992, WHEREIN LESSEE QUITCLAIMS TO THE STATE ALL RIGHT, TITLE, AND INTEREST IN AND TO THE LEASED LANDS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBITS "A", "B", AND "C" OF STATE OIL AND GAS LEASES PRC 3742, PRC 3895 AND 3998 DATED APRIL 10, 1967, DECEMBER 12, 1967 AND JULY 17, 1968, RESPECTIVELY. THE QUITCLAIMS ARE EFFECTIVE MAY 14, 1992 FOR PRC 3895 AND MAY 19, 1992 FOR PRC 3742 AND PRC 3998, THE DATES THEY WERE FILED WITH THE STATE.
3. AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF ANY DOCUMENT NECESSARY TO EFFECT THE COMMISSION'S ACTION.

6 HASTINGS SLOUGH, VICINITY OF SEAL ISLANDS" FILED AS SERIAL NO. 2564 IN BOOK
7 25 OF L.S.M. AT PAGE 21, RECORDS OF CONTRA COSTA COUNTY; THENCE FROM SAID
8 POINT OF BEGINNING ALONG SAID RESURVEY WESTERLY AND NORTHWESTERLY TO STATION
9 NO. 65 WHOSE COORDINATES ARE $X = 1,548,670.04$ AND $Y = 569,016.94$ OF SAID
10 RESURVEY; THENCE, LEAVING SAID RESURVEY, NORTH 1,300 FEET; THENCE WEST 1,900
11 FEET; THENCE NORTH 15,850 FEET; THENCE EAST 6,700 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 5,100
12 FEET; THENCE EAST 2,800 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 1,500 FEET; THENCE EAST 2,400
13 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 8,900 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO A POINT ON THE SOUTH SHORE OF
14 SUISUN BAY, SAID POINT ALSO BEING ON THE NORTHERLY BOUNDARY LINE OF THE PORT
15 CHICAGO NAVAL RESERVATION; THENCE WESTERLY AND SOUTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID NAVAL
16 RESERVATION BOUNDARY LINE TO STATION NO. 1 OF RESURVEY OF SURVEY NO. 88 AND
17 NO. 89, WHOSE COORDINATES ARE $X = 1,554,634.16$ AND $Y = 568,784.75$; THENCE
18 WESTERLY AND NORTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID RESURVEY TO STATION NO. 9; THENCE IN A
19 STRAIGHT LINE ACROSS HASTINGS SLOUGH TO STATION NO. 56, THE POINT OF BE-
20 GINNING.

21 BEARINGS, DISTANCES AND COORDINATES OF THE ABOVE RESURVEY OF SURVEY NO. 88 AND
22 SURVEY NO. 89 CONFORM WITH THE "CALIFORNIA COORDINATE SYSTEM, ZONE 3".

28 COURT CASE NO. 40184 - NIXON VS. CHAPMAN.

29 2. TIDELAND LOCATION NO. 210, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, AND TIDELAND LOCATION NO.
30 211, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, (ORIGINAL PATENT LINES OF BOTH OF THE ABOVE-
31 MENTIONED TIDELAND LOCATIONS BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN THE
32 FIELD NOTES FOR SURVEYS NOS. 210 AND 211 WHICH ARE FILED IN THE OFFICE OF
33 THE STATE LANDS DIVISION, SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA.)

34 3. SWAMP AND OVERFLOWED LANDS SURVEY NO. 609 (ROE ISLAND), SOLANO COUNTY,
35 (ORIGINAL PATENT LINES OF SAID SURVEY BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED
36 IN FIELD NOTES FOR SURVEY NO. 609 ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE
37 LANDS DIVISION IN SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA.)

38 SAID PARCEL 47 CONTAINS 3489 ACRES MORE OR LESS: THE EXCLUDED AREAS ARE
39 MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "D" OF THIS LEASE.

40 THIS LEASE IS ISSUED WITHOUT WARRANTY OF TITLE AS TO ANY OF THE LANDS
41 DESCRIBED ABOVE. IN THE EVENT THAT IT IS DETERMINED THAT THE ACREAGE OWNED
42 BY THE STATE IS MORE OR LESS THAN THAT STATED ABOVE, THE RENTAL OF ONE DOLLAR
43 PER ACRE SHOULD BE INCREASED OR DECREASED TO REFLECT THE CORRECT ACREAGE, BUT
44 THERE SHALL BE NO OTHER CHANGE IN THE AMOUNTS PAYABLE UNDER THIS LEASE.

5 of Survey No. 88 and Survey No. 89 Swamp and Overflowed Lands along
6 the shore of Suisun Bay and Hastings Slough, vicinity of Seal Islands"
7 filed as serial No. 2564 in Book 25 of L.S.M. at Page 21, records
8 of Contra Costa County; thence North 5350 ft.; thence East 10,000
9 feet, more or less, to a point in Suisun Bay on the East line of
10 State Oil and Gas Lease P.R.C. 3742.1, said point being the TRUE
11 POINT OF BEGINNING, said point also being the Southwest Corner of
12 State Oil and Gas Lease P.R.C. 3743.1; thence from said TRUE POINT
13 OF BEGINNING, East 7800 feet along the South line of said State
14 Lease; thence South 4100 feet, more or less, to a point on the
15 northerly boundary line of the Port Chicago Naval Reservation;
16 thence westerly along said Naval Reservation boundary line to the
17 Southeast corner of State Oil and Gas Lease P.R.C. 3742.1; thence
18 North 3700 feet, more or less, along the East line of said State
19 Lease, to the POINT OF BEGINNING, containing 638 acres, more or
20 less.

21 Bearings, distances and coordinates of the above description conform
22 with the "California Coordinate System, Zone 3".

23 This lease is issued without warranty of title as to any of the lands
24 described above. In the event that it is determined that the acreage owned
25 by the State is more or less than that stated above, the rental of one dollar
26 per acre should be increased or decreased to reflect the correct acreage, but
27 there shall be no other change in the amounts payable under this lease.

1 All that certain tide and submerged land in Suisun Bay, Contra Costa and
2 Solano Counties within the following-described boundary:

3 BEGINNING at Station No. 65, as shown on plat of "Resurvey of
4 Survey No. 88 and Survey No. 89 Swamp and Overflowed lands along
5 the shore of Suisun Bay and Hastings Slough, Vicinity of Seal
6 Islands" filed as Serial No. 2564 in Book 25 of L.S.M. at page
7 21, Official Records of Contra Costa County, said station having
8 coordinates X = 1,548,670.04 and Y = 569,016.94, said station
9 also being the southwesterly corner of that certain oil and gas
10 lease entered into between the State Lands Commission, State of
11 California, and Standard Oil Company of California, dated April 10,
12 1967, and designated as P.R.C. 3742.1 (Parcel 47); thence from
13 said point of beginning along the westerly boundary line of said
14 P.R.C. 3742.1 (Parcel 47) the following three courses: North 1300
15 feet, West 1900 feet, and North 15,850 feet to the northwesterly
16 corner of said P.R.C. 3742.1 (Parcel 47); thence northerly 50 feet
17 more or less to the northeasterly corner of Swamp and Overflowed
18 Land Survey 414, Solano County; thence along easterly boundary of
19 Swamp and Overflowed Land Surveys 414 and 671, Solano County, in
20 a southwesterly direction approximately 6250 feet to a point 4400
21 feet west of said westerly line of P.R.C. 3742.1 (Parcel 47); thence
22 leaving the easterly boundary of said Survey 671, south 14,500 feet
23 more or less to the northerly boundary of Tide Land Location 207;
24 thence easterly along the northerly boundary of said Location 207
25 to Station No. 74 as shown on said plat, said station having
26 coordinates X = 1,547,881.70 and Y = 568,699.29; thence easterly
27 along said resurvey to the point of beginning containing 1,720
28 acres more or less.

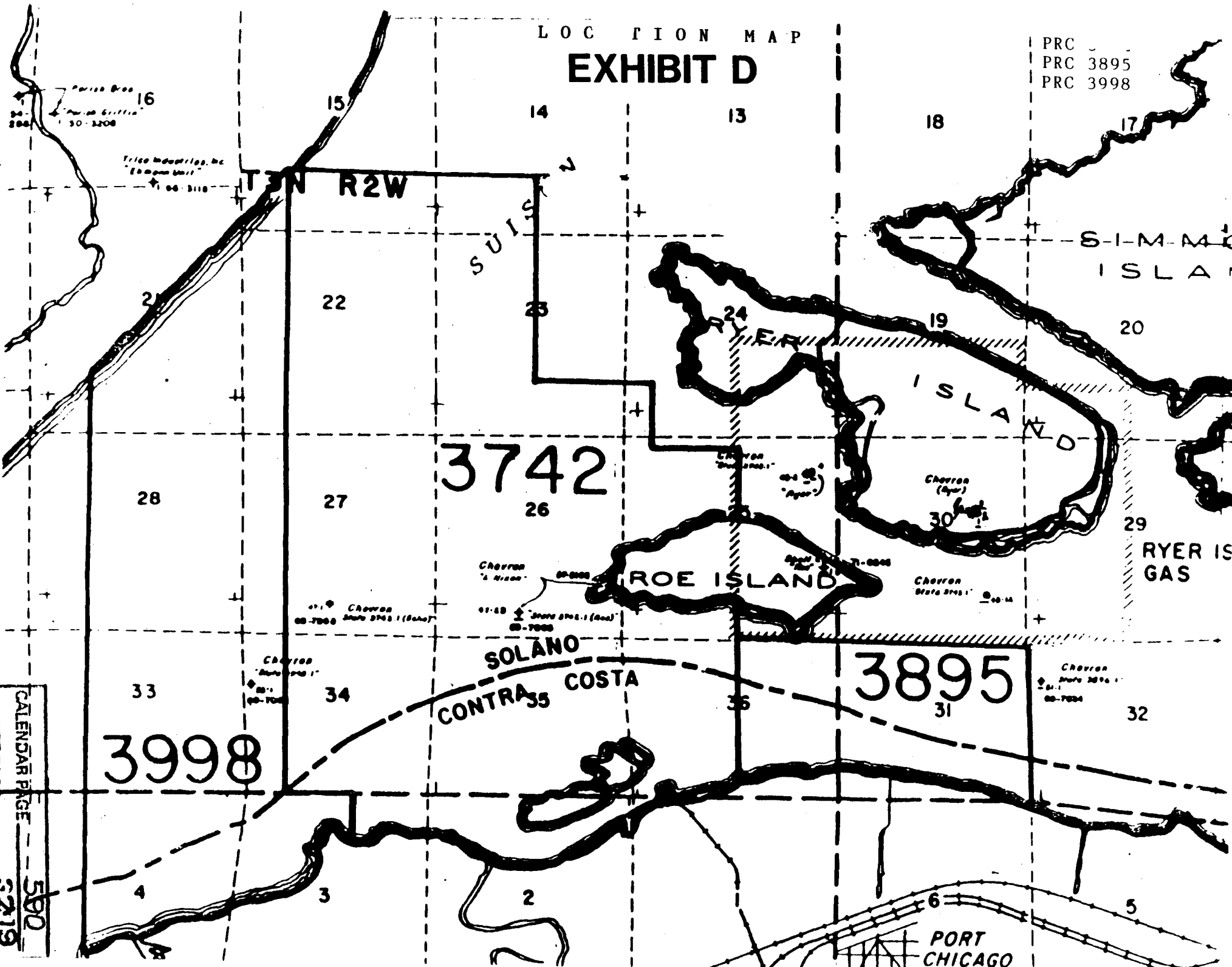
