**AUTHORIZE, AS SCHOOL LAND BANK TRUSTEE, OFFERING FOR SALE,
 THREE PARCELS OF STATE SCHOOL LAND IN SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY,
 ONE PARCEL OF STATE SCHOOL LAND IN INYO COUNTY, AND
 ONE PARCEL OF STATE SCHOOL LAND IN MONO COUNTY**

PARTY:

Pursuant to P.R.C. 8700 (School Land Bank Act) and the School Land Management Study, staff is identifying parcels of land throughout the State that either have existing surface leases that are not producing enough revenue to cover costs, or groups of smaller parcels of land with no access or leasing revenue potential. Staff has made a preliminary determination that the subject parcels fit within the above-mentioned criteria and that disposal of the parcels will provide the best return of net revenues to STRS.

Staff proposes that the Commission offer the properties for sale by competitive bid. The minimum bid will be the appraised fair market value of each plus any associated costs incurred in preparing/completing the sale will be reimbursed by the successful purchaser.

Final qualified bids will be presented to the Commission for approval and acceptance.

statutorily exempt project. The project is exempt because it involves an action taken pursuant to the School Land Bank Act, P.R.C. 8700, et seq.

2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15061, AS A STATUTORILY EXEMPT PROJECT PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 8710, AN ACTION TAKEN PURSUANT TO THE SCHOOL LAND BANK ACT, P.R.C. 8700, ET SEQ.
2. FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY IS CONSISTENT WITH THE USE CLASSIFICATION DESIGNATED FOR THE LAND PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370, ET SEQ.
3. AUTHORIZE THE STAFF TO OFFER FOR SALE, BY COMPETITIVE BID, THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF. SUBSEQUENT COMMISSION ACTION, IN CONFORMANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS, WILL BE REQUIRED TO ACCEPT BIDS, APPROVE ANY SALE, AND ISSUE A PATENT.
