### **AMENDMENT OF LEASE**

### LESSEE:

City of Sacramento
Downtown and Regional Enterprise Department
1030 15th Street, Suite 250
Sacramento, California 95814

### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands in the Sacramento River at Miller Park, near the city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Dredging of existing boat launch ramp.

### **LEASE TERM:**

Ten years, beginning August 3, 1994.

### **CONSIDERATION:**

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

### PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Dredging Lease No. PRC 7775.9 will be amended to increase the amount of dredged materials to be removed to a maximum of 3,000 cubic yards each lease year. All other terms and conditions of the lease shall remain in effect without amendment.

### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.

- Lessee has requested this amendment because it has been experiencing a high volume of siltation due to the high flows of the Sacramento River. The additional silt has been making it difficult and sometimes impossible to launch or retrieve both emergency and recreation vessels.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (d)(4).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
