### **DREDGING LEASE**

### LESSEE:

County of Marin
Department of Public Works
P. O. Box 4186
San Rafael, California 94913-4186

### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in San Francisco Bay, entrance to Paradise Cay, city of Tiburon, Marin County.

### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Maintenance dredge a maximum of 20,000 cubic yards of material to maintain a navigable depth in the entrance channel. Dredged materials will be disposed of at the United States Army Corps of Engineers approved Alcatraz Disposal Site (SF-11).

#### LEASE TERM:

Five years, beginning February 1, 1999.

### **CONSIDERATION:**

No royalty will be charged for disposal of dredged material; \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for any material used for private benefit or commercial sale purposes.

### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

 Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15304(g).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300.

2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

DREDGED MATERIALS WILL BE DISPOSED OF AT THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS APPROVED ALCATRAZ DISPOSAL SITE (SF-11). SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS. NO ROYALTY SHALL BE CHARGED FOR DISPOSAL OF DREDGED MATERIAL;
