Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Homewood, Placer County.

#### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of a pier and two mooring buoys, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

#### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning March 23, 1999.

#### CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

#### Insurance:


Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.


