DREDGING LEASE

LESSEE:

Golden Gate Bridge Highway and Transportation District P. O. Box 9000, Presidio Station San Francisco. California 94129

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands within the Larkspur Ferry channel between San Pablo Bay and the entrance to Corte Madera Creek, city of Larkspur, Marin County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Maintenance dredge a maximum of 730,000 cubic yards of material to maintain a navigable depth within the Larkspur Ferry channel. Dredged materials will be disposed of at the United States Army Corps of Engineers approved Alcatraz Disposal Site (SF-11).

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning May 1, 1999.

CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged for disposal of dredged material; \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for any material used for private benefit or commercial sale purposes.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15304(g).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California CALENDAR PAGE 00110

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2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board; United States Army Corps of Engineers; San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission.

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT OF A TEN YEAR DREDGING LEASE, BEGINNING MAY 1, 1999; FOR DREDGING A MAXIMUM OF 730,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL WITHIN THE LARKSPUR FERRY CHANNEL TO MAINTAIN A NAVIGABLE DEPTH. DREDGED MATERIALS WILL BE DISPOSED OF AT THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS APPROVED ALCATRAZ DISPOSAL SITE (SF-

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11). SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS. NO ROYALTY SHALL BE CHARGED FOR DISPOSAL OF DREDGED MATERIAL; \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED FOR ANY MATERIAL USED FOR PRIVATE BENEFIT OR COMMERCIAL SALE PURPOSES.




EXHIBIT "A"
