ACCEPTANCE OF QUITCLAIM DEED TERMINATION OF GENERAL LEASE - RECREATIONAL USE ISSUANCE OF RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

John E. McAmis and Renee C. McAmis, as Co-Trustees of the McAmis Family Trust dated December 9, 1994 3263 Shadybrook Lane Chico, California 95928

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Donner Lake, near Truckee, Nevada County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of a pier, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning November 30, 1998.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. On March 2, 1992, the Commission issued a General Lease Recreational Use to John E. McAmis and Renee McAmis for the
 construction and maintenance of a pier at Donner Lake, for a term of ten
 years. Mr. and Mrs. McAmis did not qualify for a rent-free lease due to
 the fact that the littoral parcel was a common area owned by the Donner
 Lakeside Landing Homeowners Association.
- 2. As a result of a Lot Line Adjustment survey, the littoral property was segregated among the upland property owners. Lessee is now the littoral

owner and, therefore, qualifies and has applied for a rent-free lease.

3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.


