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GENERAL LEASES - PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE USE

APPLICANTS:

Kelcey E. Chandler and James M. Yates 2765 Bechelli Lane Redding, California 96002

Kevin J. Lawson and Laurie L. Lawson 2601 Freebridge Street Redding, California 96001

John D. Barr and Teresa Ann Barr 303 Hamilton Street Redding, California 96001

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Submerged lands in the Sacramento River, adjacent to Hamilton Street, city of Redding, Shasta County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Proposed placement of approximately 2,200 cubic yards of quarried limestone rock riprap along 708 feet of eroding bank.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning June 1, 1999.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

CALENDAR ITEM NO. C28 (CONT'D)

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$500,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants own the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA under the general rule that the CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The staff believes, based upon the information available to it, that there is no possibility that this project may have a significant effect on the environment.

Authority: Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061 (b)(3).

2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
